Knit, knit, knit, knit, chicken!

(Lay a little egg for me!)

You will need:

Any coloured double knit wool Knitting needles UK size 11 (3mm) Orange felt Black thread Cotton wool balls Thin ribbon The Easter chicks are made to hold a Crème Egg, but don't worry about including these as we will provide the chocolate!

Knitting pattern

- 1. Cast on 26 stitches
- 2. Knit 1 row
- 3. Increase 1 stitch at the beginning of every row until 42 stitches are on the needle
- 4. Cast off 11 stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows (20 st)
- 5. Increase 1 stitch at the beginning of the next 4 rows (24 st)
- 6. K4 rows
- 7. K2 then 2 together to last 2 st. K2. (14 stitches)
- 8. K4 rows
- 9. K2 then 2 together to last 2 stitches. K2.
- 10. Draw wool through remaining stitches and pull tight
- 11. With that piece of wool, sew around the edge of the work to the beginning stitch leaving the cast on edge open so that the chocolate egg can be inserted
- 12. Stuff the head with cotton wool ball, sew around the neck and then gather in
- Sew two eyes with fine black wool and stick or sew a small diamond of orange felt for the beak
- 14. Tie a thin piece of ribbon around the neck for a bow
